Program Events

Veterans Day Parade

The Georgia Veterans Day Parade in Atlanta will pay tribute to roughly three-quarters of a million Georgia Veterans and their families. Our official 2022 theme is: "Wheels Up" honoring members of our military aviation – every branch of service and every type of aircraft. However, we join as a community to honor the service and sacrifices of all Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen, and Marines. We are excited to showcase our community's immense gratitude to these heroes and their enduring legacy with the annual Veterans Day Parade.

The Veterans Day Parade will begin at 11:00am and will weave its way around The Battery Atlanta and Truist Park. The Parade Reviewing Stand will be on Battery Avenue, across from the Coca-Cola Roxy. We are excited about our new parade route and the viewing opportunities that it provides. Veterans, Representatives of active-duty forces of all branches of the Armed Forces, leadership from the State's Veterans Affairs, Department of Veteran Services, Veteran Service Organizations and local politicians and celebrities are represented. The Veterans Day Parade and the Pre-Opening Ceremony are **FREE** and **open to the public**.

Veterans Festival at The Battery Atlanta

This event is to foster Atlanta's sense of patriotism, community spirit, and Atlanta's commitment to support our active military and veterans, with military vehicle displays and related themed exhibits. We have live entertainment at the stage as well as educational presentation by the National Infantry Museum, and other virtual assets. Parade winners will be presented with their trophy awards on the Georgia Power Stage after the Veterans Day Parade. The Veterans Festival at The Battery Atlanta takes place from 12:00pm to 3:00pm and is **FREE** and **open to the public**.

Observance Ceremony at Georgia Pavilion Stage and Green Space

The Veterans Day Observance is to honor and thank all veterans who served and continue to serve will be held on Saturday, November 12th at The Battery Atlanta's Georgia Power Pavilion Stage. The sit down, formal ceremony commences after the parade ends (approximately 12:00pm) with military music, parade of flags and Veteran themed speaker(s). This event is **FREE** and **open to the public**.

Freedom Ball

The evening after the Veterans Day Parade, we present the highly anticipated annual Freedom Ball. Taking place in the beautiful Oceans Ballroom of the Georgia Aquarium, we cap the Veterans Day celebration with a black-tie gala event with 500 attendees. Following the social reception, a delicious plated dinner will be followed by a moving military ceremony that honors the service of Georgia's Veterans, our featured keynote speaker, and presentation of the Marvin Myers Leadership Award. The Freedom Ball takes place from 6:00pm to 10:00pm. The Freedom Ball is the only Ticketed Event and tickets must be purchased on our website. Cost: \$100 per person, or \$1000 per table of 10.
